

QIS System Admin (IT)

[1 Day Course]

This one-day, hands on, course covers the setup, configuration and operation of QIS 6. After completing the course, participants will have the knowledge and skills needed to configure and maintain QIS 6 according to specific requirements at their locations.

Students should have solid computer skills and a basic knowledge of QIS. Topics will include: User security and roles; System and Interface Configuration; Database Management; Auto Updates and more.

This class will combine slides, discussion, demonstration and hands-on practice.
